Cornerstones -- Creating A Solid Foundation

The last several years have flown by in our support for Family Promise here in Greater Houston County—it has truly been an amazing journey. The road is long for many of our guests and for our organization as a whole, and we are not done traveling that



road yet. We are confident that we have begun to make an impact in the quest toward helping homeless families get back on their feet. Yet we know there were still 265 homeless children identified this year in the Houston County School System. We realize that because of those not counted or not in the school system there are closer to 500 total children without a home. This segment of our population is not static—it is constantly changing. There will always be families who suffer the effects of illness, death, separation, job-loss, rising debt problems, and/or the cycle of poverty. Our goal is to help solve this plight—one family at a time, and our statistics have borne out that we are helping those families find employment (over 95%) and find affordable housing (over 80%) by the time they exit the program. We have been blessed to have so many faithful stewards step forward

and make a contribution. To all of you that have made that contribution we once again want to **THANK YOU!**

Now, we are focusing on CAR CITY—Putting the Brakes On Homelessness and we need your help and support. We are asking all our supporters to contribute; you can do this in a number of ways. Certainly the easiest way is by making a financial contribution, but if you are an individual who wants to get involved, you can join us in "Experiencing Homelessness" on Sept 16th for one night.
