REACHING OUT

In 2020 Family Promise of Greater Houston County Nicole Rosser, MPA expanded our program to provide outreach services. Although we work primarily

with families in our shelter program, the past year and half has moved us to think outside of our regular program structure so we can continue to serve homeless families, or more importantly, prevent families from becoming homeless. With the support of donations from the community and a huge support from our two-year "Help Us Move In" grant, we have assisted 21 families with children. 80% of the funding used so far has assisted with prevention of homelessness with rental and utility assistance. 20% of the funds have been used for move-in expenses.

We still have funding available. Anyone interested in receiving assistance should contact our office at 478-328-8181.

Some basic guidelines in the approval process are:

- 1. Most prove residency in Georgia for the past 6 months
- 2. Must provide eviction notice or past due bill
- 3. Must have children under the age of 18 residing with you
- 4. Must show proof of employment, or proof you were employed within the past 60 days
- 5. Must show proof that children reside with you

We look forward to serving more families in Houston County.
